

Third Sunday of Easter Acts 2 Psalm 16 1 Peter 1 Luke 24



They were conversing about all the things that had occurred.

Perhaps the two disciples fleeing Jerusalem were seeking answers.

Then the One who could resolve their questions began to walk with them.


