Do not be afraid.

Jeremiah asserts his confidence in God's ultimate protection and power over the wicked who oppose him and his message The prophet prays to see the vengeance of God in regard to his enemies This wish is not what Jesus would pray for as we hear his words from the cross God's response to the plight of Jesus is to be seen in Jesus' being raised from the dead The One who went to his death at the hands of his enemies urges us in the gospel to place our entire confidence in God The Holy One does not always save from violence those who witness to His Name and action in the paschal mystery Yet we who are sent to live and proclaim the Good News are valued by God more than many sparrows In the resurrection of Jesus we have God's final word and work for us who follow Jesus and are sent by his Spirit to give fearless witness to God's Word and God's way in the world In the Lord's Supper we remember how God intervenes in our lives just as God intervened in the human life of Jesus who lived his mission fully The Eucharist is our thanksgiving for all that God has done and all that God is doing in us and our lives and mission as church
