May God bless you all!



Twentienth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Isaiah 56 Psalm 67 Romans 11 Matthew 15

A Canaanite woman was a non-believer not one of Jesus'



She asked the favor of healing for her daughter

Knowing that his mission was to his own people Jesus attempted to turn away from the woman and her request

- Yet the non-believing woman showed spunky determination and faith that persuaded Jesus to do what she asked
- If Jesus can find faith in someone not of his convictions we are challenged to look more deeply into the hearts and faith of those different from us different from our Catholic upbringing and religious education

Jesus saw the faith of a criminal crucified with him and promised him life in Jesus' kingdom

Our experience of the Eucharistic memorial of the death and resurrection of Jesus opens us to the whole mystery of human faith experiences and the unique journey of each person to the gates of the Kingdom

We can learn to see as Jesus sees to be open to the unfamiliar and surprising in human relationships

Perhaps we will find faith in God among those isolated or alien or forgotten by the rest of us

May God bless us and may all the ends of the earth revere Holy Mystery
