The worthy wife reaches out her hands to the poor.

In Matthew's parable a man gives different amounts of resources for producing an increase in the amounts bestowed
Then he went away.

When Jesus left the visible world he left his disciples with what they need for the his ongoing mission among them
As his disciples in the present age what do we do in his apparent absence
What is the well done he will find we have done when we meet him

The First World Day of the Poor faces us with the mission Jesus gives us to preach in word and deed good news to the impoverished
Such good news comes in the love we extend in tangible care for those in need of assistance
Such good news is the presence of Jesus showing care in the way his disciples reach out their hands after the manner of the worthy wife in Proverbs

In the Eucharist we have nothing for us to give to God except our way of living in God's love
As we offer ourselves to God's grace united to the paschal mystery we realize our own poverty enriched by the dying and rising of Jesus

The Body and Blood of Christ transform us into trustworthy servants intimately bonded to Jesus
