Jonah 3 Psalm 25 1 Corinthians 7 Mark 1 Third Sunday in Ordinary Time



### They left boats and nets behind and followed Jesus

After God had put Jonah
through the wringer a few times
the prophet finally followed
God's instructions
as in today's first reading
Jonah had tried to control God's mercy
to conform to his own biases
The prophet could not stand the idea
that God could save foreigners
The fishermen who left boats and nets
to follow Jesus gave him
a blank check on their lives
How different they were from Jonah

How different they were from Jonah who did at last carry out God's intent for the people of Nineveh

Imagine the burden of carrying boats and nets along the paths that Jesus took

What compelled the first disciples to follow this wandering preacher For us the question is

What leads us to follow Jesus
We need to look to the things
we might carry that have to
be left behind and see
what prejudgments are getting free rent
in our minds and preventing us
from fulfilling our mission
with Jesus and his Spirit in the lead

In reenacting the paschal mystery in the Eucharist we are challenged to leave all behind that keeps us from walking all the way in Jesus' path



Based on an anticipated weekly allotment, Shelby County Health Department) (SCHD) will begin offering vaccinations on an appointment-only basis at the Pipkin Building at the Shelby County Fairgrounds each Tuesday – Saturday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Appointments may be made on the online appointment app SignUpGenius at this link: <a href="https://www.signupgenius.com/go/">https://www.signupgenius.com/go/</a>

JanCOVID19Signup. Those without internet access are to call 901-222-SHOT(7468) for assistance in scheduling an appointment beginning 8:00 a.m., Monday, January 11, 2021. The Health Department will add other vaccination sites throughout the county as the vaccine campaign moves forward.

#### **Registration for Veterans**

VA.gov has launched a site for gathering information from Veterans interested in being vaccinated COVID-19 vaccines: Stay informed and help us prepare | Veterans Affairs. The site allows VA employees to enter information into the electronic form for a Veteran who mentions wanting a vaccine.
