



Written by Michelle Alexander, esteemed civil rights lawyer and legal scholar, this bestselling and award-winning book argues that "we have not ended racial caste in America; we have merely redesigned it" through a costly, discriminatory legal structure. Far-reaching in its influence, *The New Jim Crow* has been called "the spark that would eventually light the fire of Black Lives Matter."

Dr. Nichols is organizing pastor of Freedom's Chapel Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). She was also the first ordained clergy woman to serve as visiting professor at the Gweru Baptist Theological Seminary in Gweru, Zimbabwe, South Africa. Dr. Nichols travelled as a church planter throughout the provinces of China and participated in a renewal pilgrimage to Galilee and Jerusalem.

Dr. Nichols is also a native Memphian, who graduated from historic Booker T. Washington High School, LeMoyne Owen College, and Memphis Theological Seminary. Then she was awarded her Doctor of Ministry Degree from historically black Virginia Union University in Richmond, VA.

Dr. Nichols is a founding member of Memphis Interfaith Coalition for Action and Hope (MICAH); also Memphis Leadership Graduate; lifetime NAACP member; Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority - Beta Epsilon Omega Chapter member. Dr. Nichols deepest passions: teaching, preaching, working with others for the beloved community of God.
