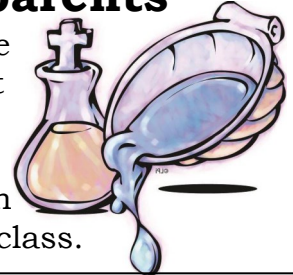

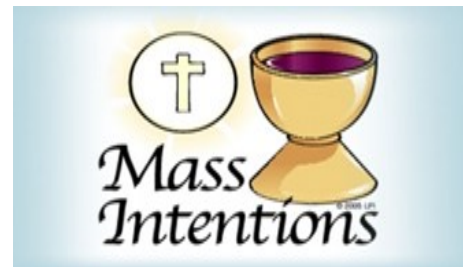

Lifting of Covid-19 Restrictions by the Bishop

A Note from Fr. Val

Earlier this month Bishop David issued a new Decree, effective on Sunday, May 30th, at St. Patrick's. As the Bishop put it in his accompanying note, "Holy water fonts, Processions for the Offertory, Sign of Christ's Peace, a full nave...all save the offering of the chalice (for the time being)...is part of the weekend of 29-30 May."

I want to make some observations:

- All the pews have been returned to their original position within the church.
- As the Bishop puts it in his Decree, "Facial coverings (masks) are recommended but optional."
- No one will be "checked" to see if they are vaccinated. However, if you haven't been vaccinated yet, you *must* wear a mask at all times while you are on the St. Patrick campus, until you are vaccinated. This is a very serious matter. Younger children in our parish have not yet had the chance to be vaccinated. We all want them to be protected. Their parents are putting their trust in your honesty regarding the protection of their vulnerable children.
- At Communion time, we shall return to the practice of coming up the main, central aisle in order to receive Holy Communion—two by two. Those who will be administering the Eucharist will wear masks at that time.
- I suggest that, if you feel uneasy with the restrictions lifted: Come to the 5:15 p.m. Sunday Mass. There are many fewer persons at this Mass.

BECOMING CATHOLIC

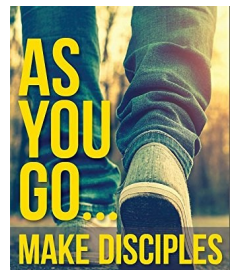

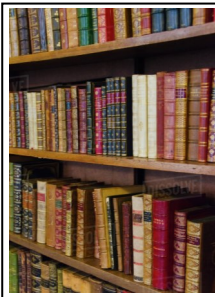
