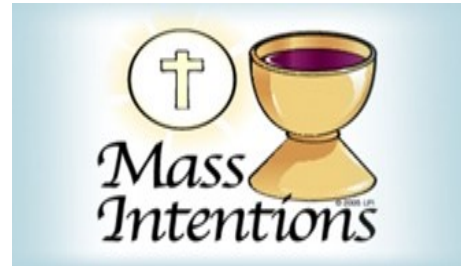

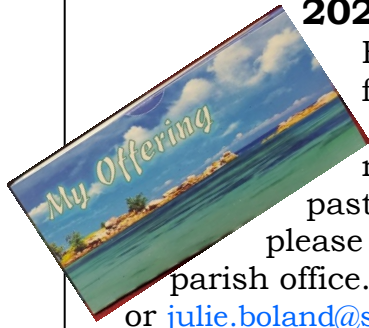

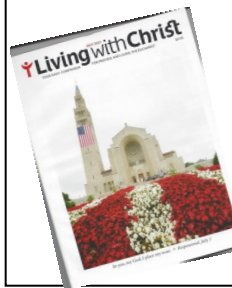

St. Patrick Church Supports New Healthy Baby and Parent Assistance Ministry

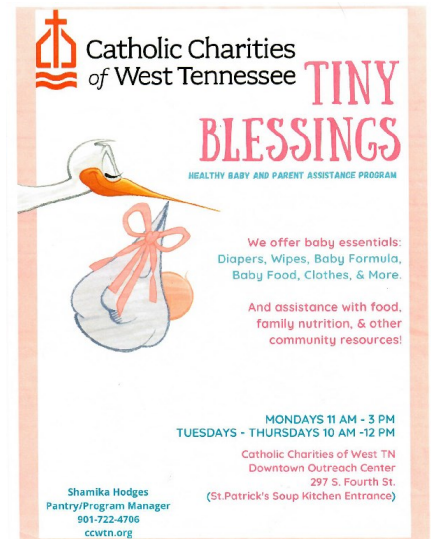


Catholic Charities is sponsoring a baby and parent assistance ministry under the direction of Shamika Hodges who also directs the St. Patrick Food Pantry. Shamika has asked for help distributing flyers to get the word out about the program called, "Tiny Blessings" which also assists with food, family nutrition and connecting families with other community resources. In addition to

diapers, other baby essentials are available including wipes, formula, baby food, clothes and more.

It has been well documented that children who have had to endure wearing the same diaper for extended periods of time suffer much trauma due to pain. The lack of diapers can lead to some parents trying to force early potty training on children not developmentally ready for this task. Child abuse can accompany such efforts. Food stamps do not cover the cost of disposable diapers and many low income families do not have the resources for cloth diapers which require a washer and dryer. Having diapers available for families who cannot otherwise afford them can be a life changer for babies, infant to toddler.

Please state your days and times of availability. Teams will be formed to place fliers with apartment dwellers, stores and other locations in the neighborhood.

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

A Catechesis of the Good Shepherd **Infant-Toddler Course** was hosted by the Good Shepherd Center at St Patrick the week of June 7-12, with 25 participants from the area and from several other states. We were honored to have two Missionaries of Charity join us, one of whom came from Dallas, and we were especially pleased that two St. Patrick parishioners attended: Julie Long and Marilyn Jenkins. We are very grateful to St. Patrick parish for providing a dedicated space for serving infants and toddlers, to Phil Woodard for the construction work to get the room ready, to Bridget Heureman for her beautiful work painting the materials, to Julie Boland for helping with handouts, and to Shannon Curtis for being our AV manager and offering an array of support, and, as always, to Fr. Val for his ongoing support of CGS at St. Patrick.



A special treat was the visit of Bishop David on Friday, June 11. Father Val and Deacon Frank joined us as Bishop David shared with us his own conversion to the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (which had led him to complete two 90-hour courses in it!) and his hopes for its becoming more deeply rooted in the Memphis Diocese.

We of the St. Patrick Good Shepherd atrium program have been very blessed in having such a beautiful space in the Annex for the atria serving children 3-12+ and very much look forward to opening the new infant-toddler atrium and welcoming back those families that have refrained from coming during COVID. We are hoping to be up and running again by early September.

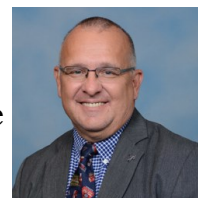
