

Ida B. Wells Celebration Week

Ida Bell Wells-Barnett lived in Memphis, Tennessee for 10 years as an educator, a journalist, an anti-lynching advocate, a champion of civil rights and women's suffrage. She risked her life to oppose oppression, racism, and violence in America. But when she lived in Memphis, her life was threatened and her office on Beale Street was destroyed and she was run out of town. She is honored for her heroic stand on injustice and inspired change



and challenged American societal ailments.

For over 20 years, St. Patrick has led the "Stations of the Cross Through the Neighborhood" annually on Good Friday. The 12th Station is the Ida B Wells historical marker (dedicated in 1987) on Beale Street where her Free Speech and Headlight office was located. The 13th Station is the historic Beale Street Baptist Church, which Ida B Wells attended.

Now we dedicate a memorial to her heroism, and to inspire those who continue her legacy. Come join the Memphis community in honoring and celebrating this amazing African American woman at the Ida B Wells Plaza at Beale and 4th Streets.
