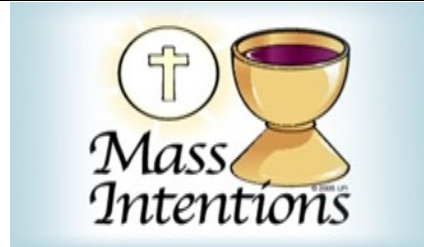

## Commemoration of Hiroshima and Nagasaki August 6 and 9



**Sunflowers** are the *symbol of a world free of nuclear weapons*. In view of the upcoming anniversaries of the atomic bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, a presentation of sunflowers or sunflower images in church reminds us of our role in freeing the world of nuclear weapons.

**Paper cranes:** ancient Japanese tradition holds that one who folds a thousand paper cranes will receive what one wishes for. Today, cranes signify our determination to eliminate nuclear weapons.



Sunday by Sunday is a ready-to-use 4 page weekly that prompts faith-sharing on the Sunday readings. Each issue provides prayer to begin and end sessions. The cover introduces experiences that link to the gospel and a question that invites stories from the group.
