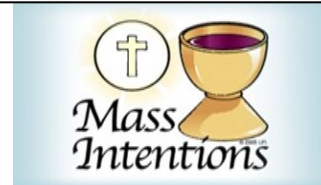

Greeters offer a joyful welcome to established parishioners, newcomers and visitors alike as we gather to share in the Liturgy.

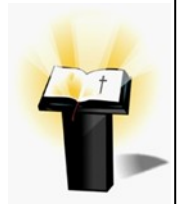


Altar Servers
