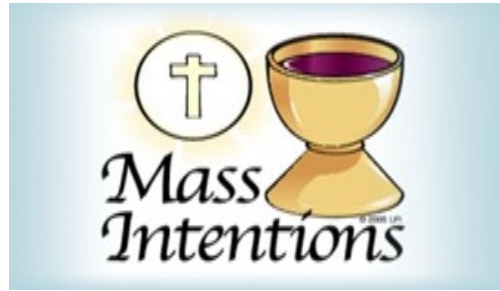

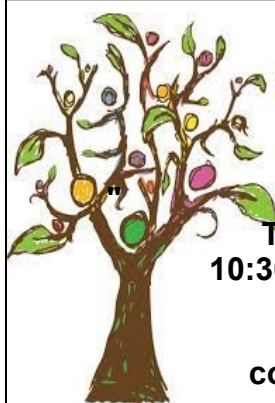

Each parishioner may vote for up to four (4) candidates. Please vote only once.

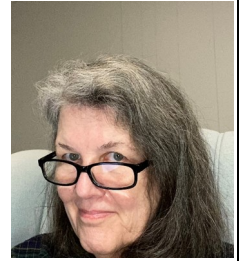

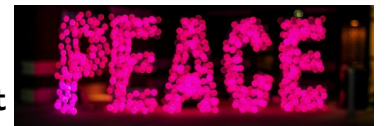

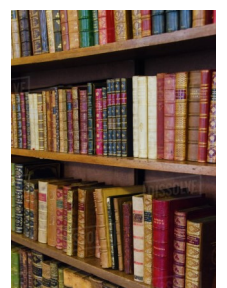
