thought about becoming Catholic, the St. Patrick Community extends a heartfelt invitation to explore the Catholic faith.





Blessed First Holy Communion



Today at the 11:00 Mass we celebrate the First Communion of eight children of our St. Patrick parish: Luke Heuerman, Elaina Long, Elsa Korneliussen, Bryan Dominguez, Brenna Stratton, Aiden Williams, Teresa Hernandez, and Lia Baltazar. We are pleased to also have six children from Rebekah's atrium at the Missionaries of Charity.

These children have all been formed in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, in which the First Communicants wear a white garment

that recalls their Baptism. At our Baptism our name was called by the Good Shepherd to receive His risen life and light. The white garment we wore as infants for our Baptism was a sign that we were "*a new creation, clothed in Christ*" and the priest went on to pray: "*See in this white garment the outward sign of your Christian dignity. With your family and friends to help you by word and example, bring that dignity unstained into everlasting life.* Now, we wear the white garment and carry our baptismal candle to this new encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist, which is also a foretaste
