

## Hi, St. Patrick's



As your new Pastoral Council met at the beginning of June, we discussed the importance of Pope Francis's push for us to be a synod-

al church. While we, as a church, have started to address the "listening" portion of the appeal, there's another part we haven't worked on much - journeying together. Considering this phrase can take on many forms, we specifically discussed how we can journey together to announce the Gospel. As we all weighed in, there were many common words and themes we came back to. Some important words we shared: mercy, love, faith, good news, community, inclusion, respect, humility. Some recurring phrases we considered: preaching through both word and action, reflection with the Gospels, Jesus becoming human for understanding and relatability, the power of prayer, how we as a community can better be impacting the world at large, Catholic universality.

Needless to say, we opened up many doors and peeked through each one, but there is definitely still more time to be spent and conversations to have. Thankfully, we were also able to be transparent with feelings and thoughts, especially in relation to the world today. One topic that arose was how do we, as individuals and as a community, affect change in non-local places of need such as the war in Ukraine, the increase in gun violence, etc. Understandably, many of us feel overwhelmed and heavily saddened by these events, and feel helpless in terms of actually affecting positive, visible change.

First of all, know that you are not alone in feeling this way! Many of the council members and the people in our community share a similar sentiment. Secondly, prayer may be all we can do. Not only do we need to be praying for those affected by these tragedies, the leadership controlling decisions and policies, and for the safety of our community, family, and friends, but also each other. We have to trust in God's love, mercy, and power, and know that He is with us and with those who need Him. Moving forward, we hope to assist you and the parish community with any needs, wants, and/or suggestions, so feel free to open up a conversation with us or with others around you about what journeying together looks like, feels like, and how the council can help make that a reality. Also consider how you can work to live out the Gospels every day through action, word, and prayer - Jesus's words won't lead us astray. - Hannah Schultz


