





This just in... News from your Pastoral Council

At our June meeting, the Pastoral Council continued a practice begun at our retreat last year: building a Covenant Community by sharing an important part of our **faith development**, our "racial autobiographies." Deacon Frank shared his this time, and we hope our new Council members will share theirs over our next several meetings. Reflecting on and sharing these stories of our own personal racial identity development is crucial, we feel, to being a truly diverse and inclusive community. Ask a Council member about it!

Pastoral Council

A related consideration of the Pastoral Council is helping St. Pat's **become more of a "listening church" through the synodal process**. We are starting with ourselves, and adopting a format of "mutual

invitation" for our monthly meetings, and for our upcoming Re-Orientation on September 3. The mutual invitation process allows each person to speak uninterrupted to the matter at hand, if they so choose, and then to invite another person to speak. The process ensures that all voices around the table are heard. We are struggling, as you might expect, with this counter-cultural process, since we are culturally conditioned to "speak up" and "say our piece," rather than listen—but we are diligently working on it. We hope you will take advantage of our intention, and *talk* to a council member about your concerns and hopes. Your Council members want, not only to listen to all the voices around our table, but also to bring more folks from the margins to a seat at the table. Please tell us how you would want us to do that.

Since St. Pat's is an institutional member of MICAH, the Pastoral Council also wants to support the **efforts of MICAH members** working to help the residents displaced from the former Foote Homes (in St. Pat's backyard) return to homes in Foote Park, if they so desire. Half of the units have been completed and occupied, and the formal **dedication of Foote Park** will be September 30. We ask that you keep checking the bulletin for more information about this celebration and that you attend the dedication, if you are able.

The **search for a Youth Ministry Director** continues, as well. The Pastoral Council had hoped to hear from many of our parish youth at the June 23 Youth Town Hall meeting, but the turnout was not large or comprehensive... so we'll just be trying again! If you would like to give your feedback on the needs and desires of our youth ministry program, please contact any member of the Council. We want to know your thoughts in order to draft a job description for Youth Director that truly reflects what our youth want and need.

Finally, we are delighted to report that Council member Lester Brown has agreed to coordinate a **dedicated Hospitality Ministry** at St. Pat's. This ministry would include, but not be limited to, those who serve as greeters at each of the Masses and those who help with coffee hour after the morning Masses. (We hope Lester and his team will also create a fellowship opportunity for the 5:15 Mass!) We all know we are, and we want to continue to be, an intentionally welcoming community, so be sure to thank Lester for getting us organized. And if you think you have been given the gift of hospitality, let Lester know that you're ready to share it with others at brownmmemphis69@bellsouth.net.
