



Mary of Magdala Celebration: Apostle to the Apostles



Mary Magdalene, also called Mary of Magdala, was a constant companion of Jesus during his ministry in Galilee and was one of his earliest followers. She is mentioned by name twelve times in the canonical gospels, more than most of the apostles and more than any other woman in the gospels, other than Jesus's family.

Loyal to the last, Mary witnessed the crucifixion and the interment of Jesus' body in the tomb.

In all four gospels, she was the first recorded witness of the Resurrection. According to John, the resurrected Jesus singled Mary out from all others, charging her alone to bring news of his transcendence over death to his disciples.

#### Procedure for Reporting Sexual Abuse

Anyone who has knowledge of or who has cause to suspect an incident of sexual abuse should report the information to the appropriate civil authorities first at 1-877-237-0004, then to the Diocesan Director of Child & Youth Protection at 901-359-2027 or the Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator at 901-652-4066.
