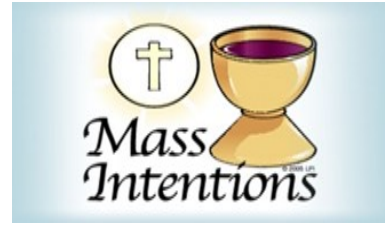

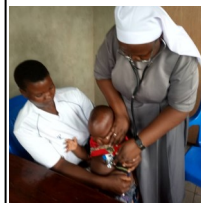

St. Patrick Tanzania Global Health Ministry Update



St. Patrick's parishioners are joining forces with Catholic sisters in Tanzania to fund a medical clinic. Funds are being raised not only for construction but also for supplies and equipment.



So far, we have raised \$3,800, and are hoping to raise another \$2,800 to complete the construction of the clinic. The clinic will serve about 900 people a year and enable doctors to not only provide care in the village of Kifuru but also in the surrounding rural areas that currently lack care. This clinic will provide maternity care and ongoing care for young mothers and their children.

A special benefit dinner is set for **Sept. 10 at 6 p.m.** featuring Tanzania dishes, specially prepared by Inspire Cafe and hosted by Barrie and Mike Simpson at their home in Central Gardens.
