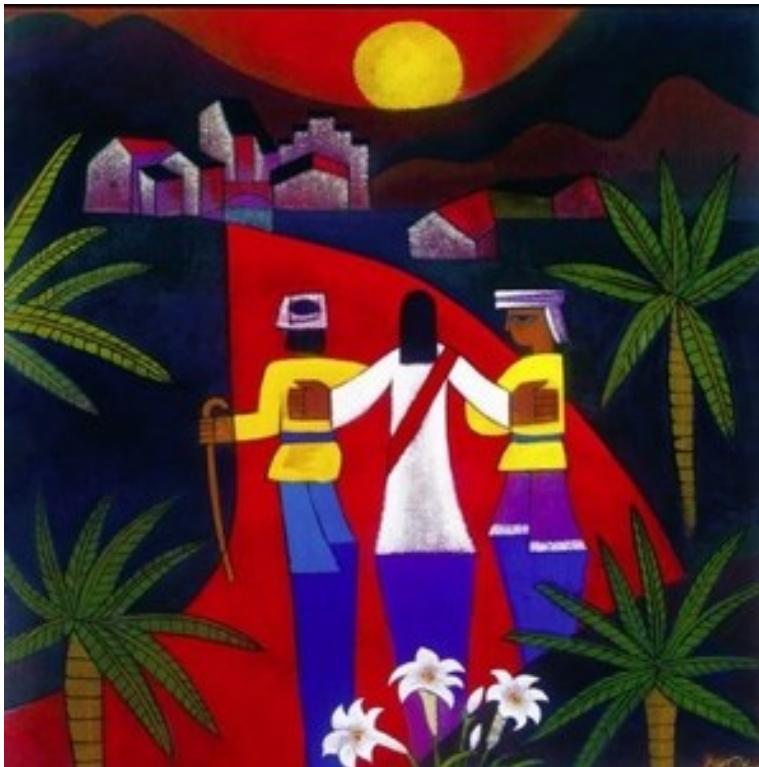

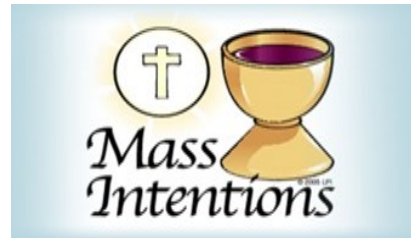

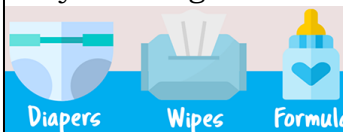
Prayer for Ukraine

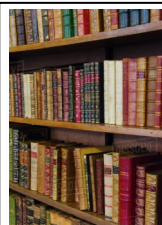
