

#### **First Communion**

Sunday, April 30 11 o'clock Mass

Why are our First Communicants wearing a white alb with a red cross?

At our Baptism our name was called by the Good Shepherd to receive his risen life and enter his sheepfold, the Church. The white garment we wore as infants for our Baptism was a sign that we were "a new creation clothed in Christ." And the priest went on to pray: "See in this white garment the outward sign of your Christian dignity. With your family and friends to help you by word and example, bring that dignity unstained into everlasting life."

From the youngest ages in the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd we ponder and enjoy the liturgical signs of Baptism, including the white garment. We believe the richness of this sign should not be lost or forgotten. Now we wear it to this new encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist, which is also a foretaste of the heavenly banquet. And we also carry our baptismal candles as a reminder of the gift of the light and life of the Risen Christ which we received in our Baptism, echoed in the words of the prayer the priest prayed. "These children of yours have been enlightened by Christ. They are to walk always as children of the light. May they keep the flame of faith alive in their hearts. When the Lord comes, may they go out to meet him with all the saints in the heavenly kingdom."






