

Ovell Irby (Black on Beale) 1958-2023

Black was an able-bodied man, but homeless. In 2000 he lost his ability to walk. He slept on the rectory porch, hauling himself up into a wheelchair (Deacon Eugene) for the day. Many in the parish reached out to him-coffee, sandwiches, rides, haircuts, cash. Fr. Val asked for help. With legal (Ginny Crutcher) and medical (Joe Weems) input, he applied and received Social Security Disability and TNCare. Medical exam (critically by Dr. Alan Nadel) showed a benign brain tumor. After surgery he could walk again. He lived in a safe, clean home with three hot meals a day (and color tv). He was in touch with his daughter Kizzie and grandchildren. He had a severe stroke in 2023 and died recently. A memorial service was held at Ford Funeral Home on Saturday May 6. I found him to be strong, smart, with a wry sense of humor and surprisingly without complaints about his hard life. Joe Weems


