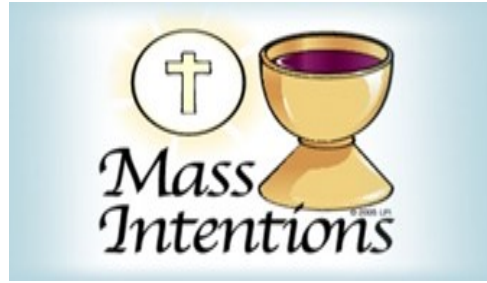

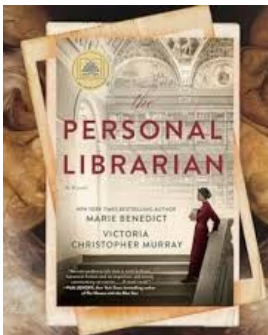

Also, Dave is a faithful lector for Sunday Mass.

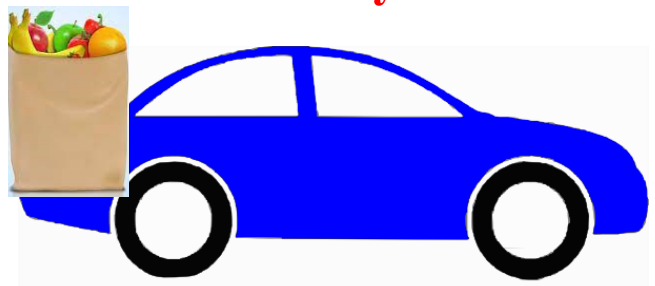

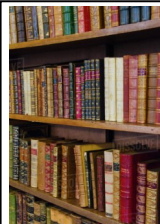
