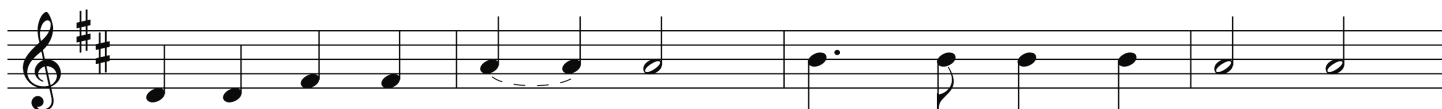

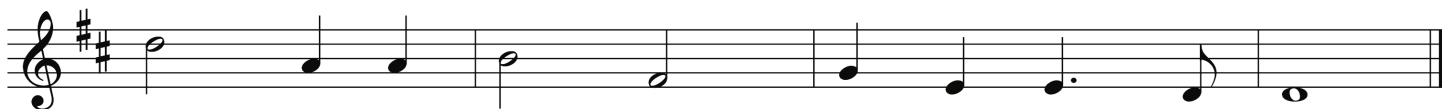

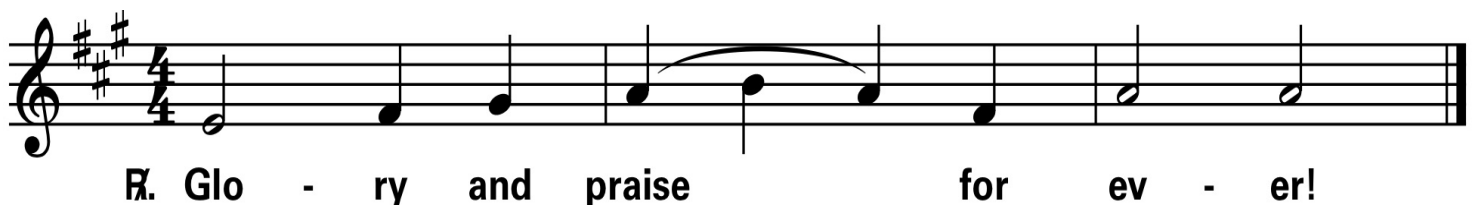
First Reading: Exodus 34.4b-6, 8-9

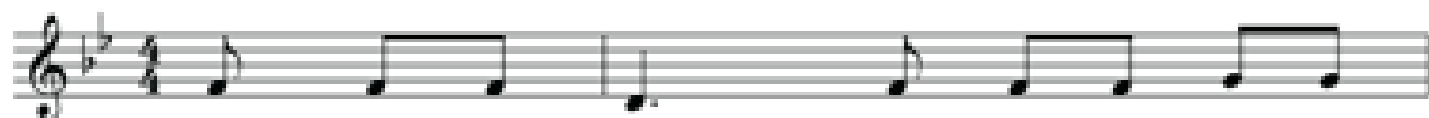

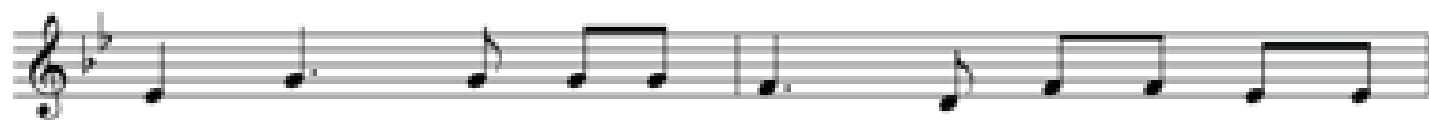
Profession of Faith:

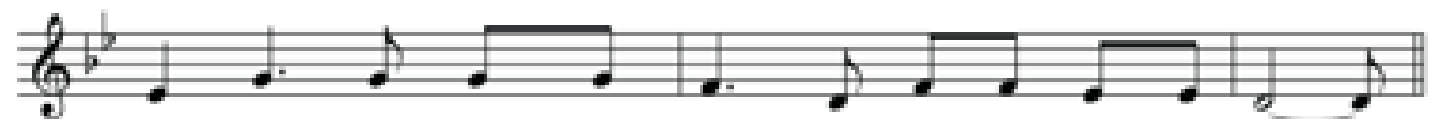

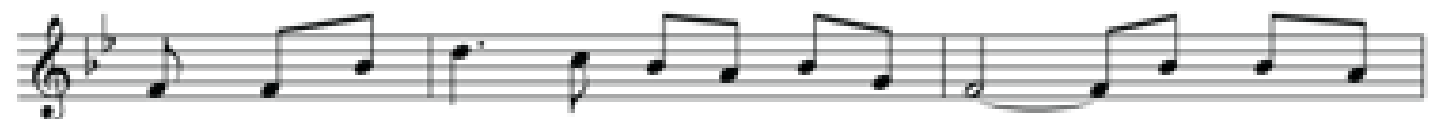

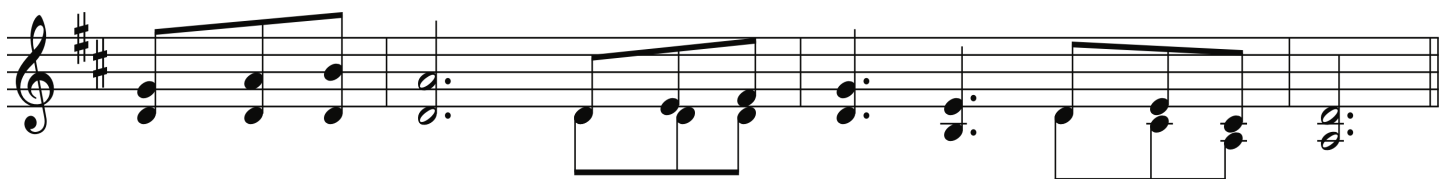
