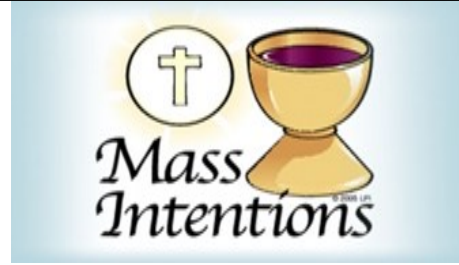

### New Minister to the Sick Training



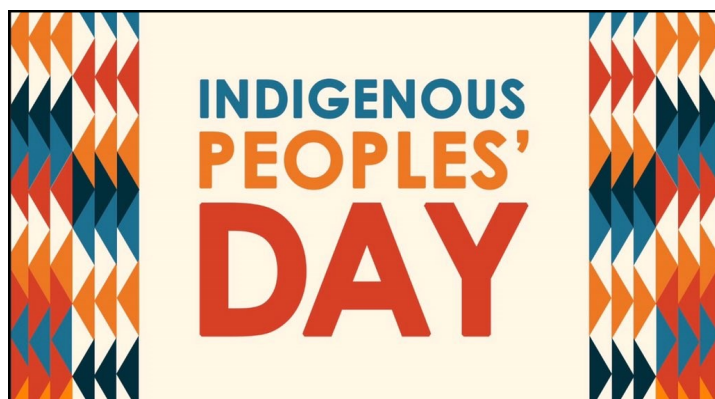
This Ministry conducts pastoral visits with time to listen and pray about the concerns of the sick or shut-in person and to share the Eucharist with them.

Anyone who has knowledge of or who has cause to suspect an incident of sexual abuse should report the information to the appropriate civil authorities first at 1-877-237-0004, then to the Diocesan Director of Child & Youth Protection at 901-359-2027 or the Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator at 901-652-4066.
