The remainder of the events will be held at St. Brigid Catholic Church and will include a [\\$10,000 Cash Raffle](#), [Carnival Rides and Attractions](#), [Car Show](#), [BBQ Cooking Contest](#), [Vendor Fair](#), Two-Day [Music Festival](#) with top local bands, [Food Truck Fair](#), [Cabana Space Rental](#) and a ticketed national [concert](#) titled "Live on the Field," with headliner 38 Special, with opening act The Shotgun Billys.

Admission is \$5 per person with a maximum single-family fee of \$20. Parking is free off-site with free shuttle transportation. On-site parking is available for \$20.
