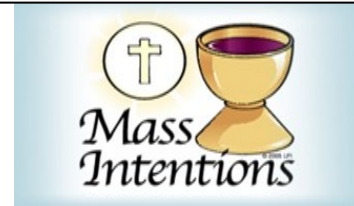

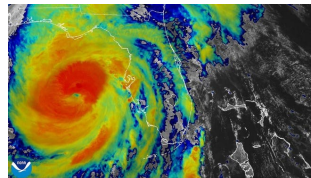
Hurricane Helen Relief Second Collection Next Sunday, October 13

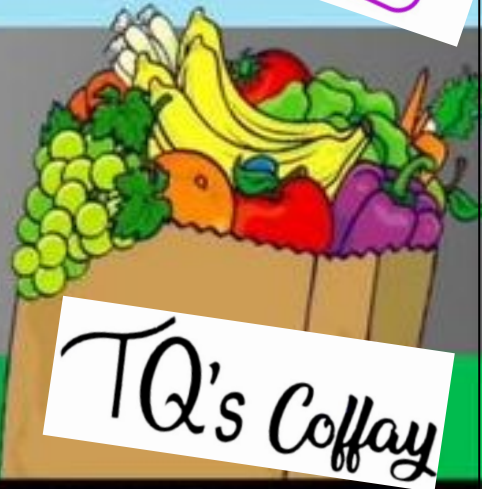

Admission is \$5 per person with a maximum single-family fee of \$20. Parking is free off-site with free shuttle transportation. On-site parking is available for \$20.
